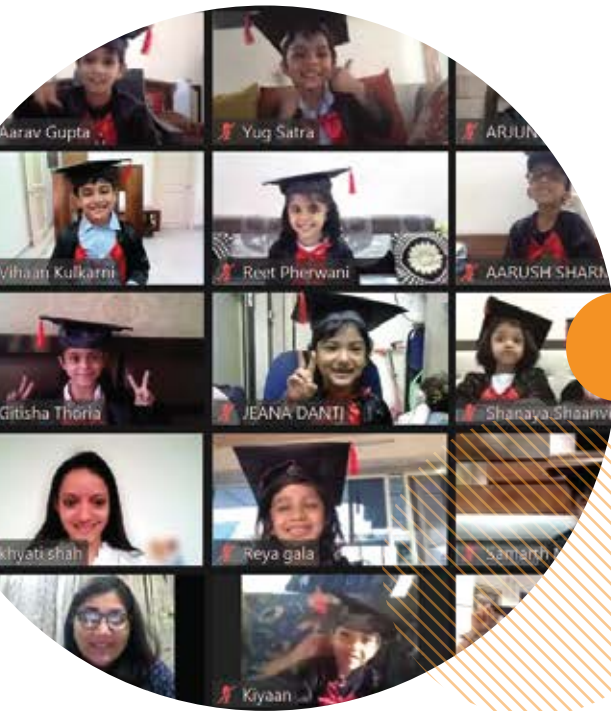

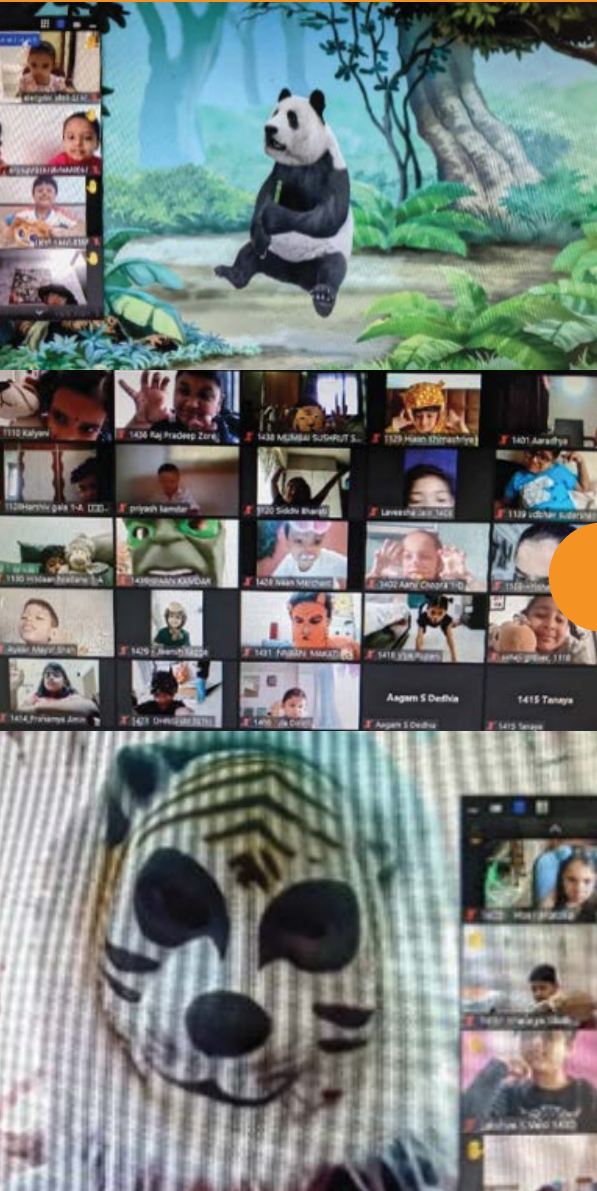

New Concept



Grade 1

English 2 Jungle adventure

For the prose – Meet the lions, a jungle adventure was organized, where the kids were informed beforehand to dress up in animal print and animal masks. A PPT was shown which took the kids around the jungle and showed them different animals. It also had puzzles and games where the kids were asked to guess the animal. It was a very enjoyable and exciting experience for the kids.

Grade 2

English 1 Topic - Prepositions

Teacher initiated the game of hide and seek, wherein one child was asked to hide somewhere in the vicinity of the camera (the child was kept in the spotlight) while others closed their eyes to the count of 5. The other children then guessed the location of the hidden child, using various prepositions during the play. Eg: Behind the curtain, under the table/bed, in the balcony/bathroom, on the bed... so on. Like-wise many children were given turns to hide while the others guessed. Thus the topic of Prepositions was explained in a fun and exciting way.



New Concept

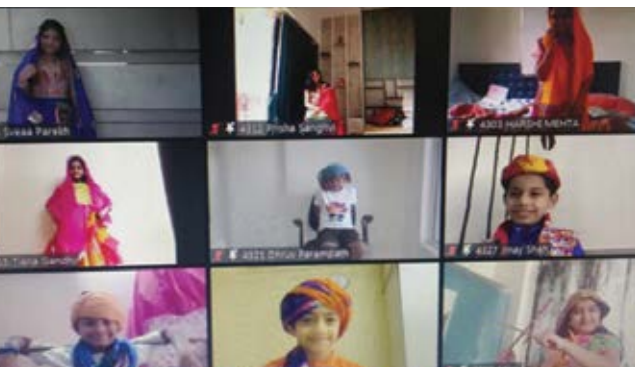


Grade 2

They learnt about the concept of division and grouping hands by dividing the objects in various groups. They learnt about the properties of division through their active participation.



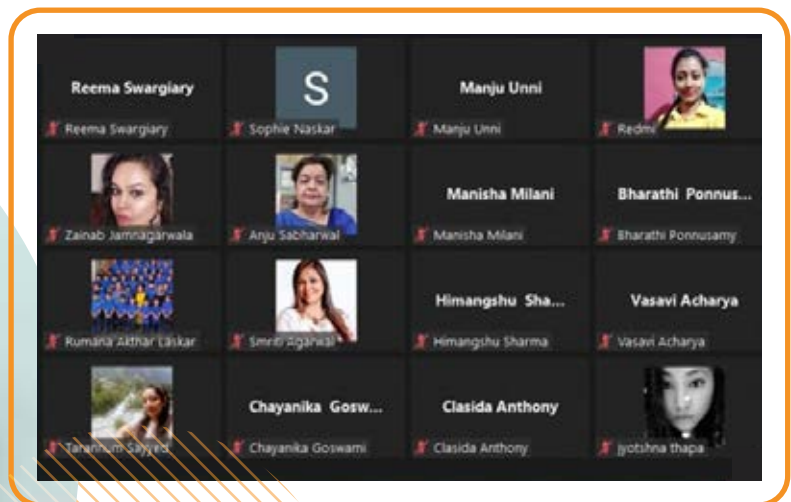
Social Studies

Topic - The States of Great Indian Desert

Grade 4

Students celebrated the essence of Indian culture by dressing up as per the tradition of the states of Great Indian Desert. They depicted the particular state by speaking about its important features, culture and traditions; as guides to the tourists (other classmates)

They delivered two to three famous dialects which enriched their understanding of the region. Students also pointed out the difficulties and challenges faced by rural and urban inhabitants of these states which was indeed a great initiative to connect with the roots - its related issues, understand the issues faced and to suggest solutions; thus encouraging students to cultivate a scientific approach and a sense of tolerance.
